New Members - Plans are being made for a communicant's class for people wishing to become communicant members.

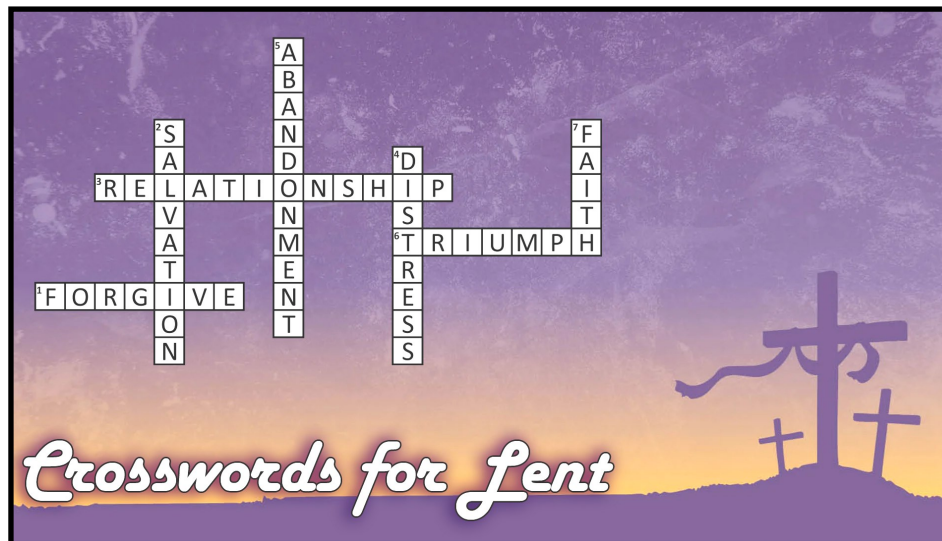
Good Friday service - A Good Friday service will be held at St. Andrew's on Friday, April 3, 2026 at **10:00 a.m.** Communion will be served at this service.
