

Outreach Ministry Team Reports: An Update from Samaritan's Purse:

Last year, millions of Operation Christmas Child shoe box gifts were donated to children across the world. One of the countries who received shoe box gifts was Cambodia. Each shoebox was stuffed to the brim with gifts that make a child smile. In each box was also included an invitation to the Samaritan's Purse discipleship programme The Greatest Journey. If they take this programme, it can be a turning point in a child's life where they become fully committed and understand what it means to be a Christian.

Last year alone, almost 23,000 children in Cambodia decided to follow Jesus after participating in The Greatest Journey. It takes an army of volunteers in Canada and local churches in Cambodia to reach so many people.

Volunteers from local Cambodian churches tell us that, "Most people who pack shoe boxes will never set foot inside a classroom of The Greatest Journey "but the local Cambodian volunteers want us to understand "the incredible impact a single box has on a community." Because of our shoeboxes, there are smiles on children's faces. The joy, laughter, the cheering, seeing their joy, it is because we have been able to bless them. Let us pray that each of the millions of shoebox gifts will show a child God's love and that many of these boys and girls will participate in The Greatest Journey and become lifelong followers of Jesus.

The goal of Samaritan's Purse is to fill 750 classrooms of The Greatest Journey by August 25, 2026. Each classroom provides a workbook, a graduation certificate, and a New Testament in the child's language (often the first Bible that family has ever owned.)

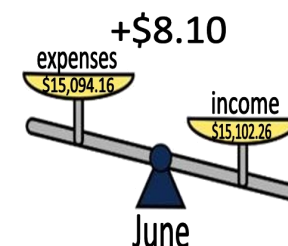
